RULES & REGULATIONS

All contestants in Marshall County are eligible to participate when meeting the qualifications outlined below:
Please keep this sheet for you reference!

1. Contestant must be a resident of Marshall County.
2. Contestant must be a female, at least seventeen (17) years of age and cannot have had her twenty-first (21) birthday as of June 20, 2021.
3. Contestant must be unmarried, must never have been married, and cannot have had a child or be knowingly pregnant at the time of the pageant. If the contestant becomes pregnant during her reign, she will be required to relinquish her title. The contestant may not be a current reigning queen.
4. If chosen as 2021 Miss Blueberry you will be required to remain single through the following pageant.
5. Your reign as 2021 Miss Blueberry will continue until the following year's Miss Blueberry is chosen.
6. No professional model is eligible for this pageant. (A professional model is one whose livelihood is modeling). A contestant who has previously completed in The Indiana State Festival Scholarship Pageant cannot do so again.
7. Judging is divided into three (3) areas:

Interview/Professional Wear	40 Points
Theme Wear: At "Faith, Family, Farming" how are these 3 things important in today's world?	30 Points
Evening Gown	30 Points
8. The Pageant Committee reserves the right to change the foregoing Rules & Regulations as necessary at any time.
9. **A completed form with photograph (head shot) and baby photo, must be postmarked or delivered to the Blueberry Office by 5:00pm on May 10, 2021.**

The 2021 Miss Blueberry Festival will receive a One Thousand Two Hundred Fifty Dollar, (\$1,250.00) Scholarship, a tiara, trophy, sash, and other miscellaneous gifts.

The First Runner-up will receive a Seven Hundred Fifty Dollar, (\$750.00) Scholarship, trophy, sash, and other miscellaneous gifts.
The First Runner-up will replace the 2021 Miss Blueberry should circumstances dictate.

The Second Runner-up will receive a Five Hundred Dollar (\$500.00) Scholarship, trophy, sash, and other miscellaneous gifts.

Miss Friendship (chosen by the contestants) will receive a One Hundred Dollar (\$100.00) cash prize, trophy, sash, and other miscellaneous gifts.

A Two Hundred Dollar (\$200.00) cash prize for interview. A One Hundred Dollar (\$100.00) cash prize for theme. A One Hundred Dollar (\$100.00) cash prize for gown.

All contestants will receive a contestant T-Shirt and miscellaneous gifts.
